Operations Committee MEETING: Minutes of first 2005 Ops Meeting held immediately after the General Membership meeting on January 29, 2005

WWRA Chief Operator, Joe, W7COM convened a meeting of the operations committee members George, N7GME, Bill, N7YT, Mike, W7MKY, Ed, KD7YRW and alternate operations committee members Don, KC7VQD [absent], Kevin, WQ1B, Jaime, KD7HPE and Mike, W7CO and himself to elect the CHIEF OPERATOR of the WWRA for 2005. The first five members of the operations committee are voting members who vote in the Chief Operator. All operations members including the alternate members are equal in all other respects for qualification to be control operators.

Voting of the Chief Operator. There are three members currently qualified to be chief operator. Since Bill, N7YT is treasurer and the constitution prohibits one member from holding two offices and now Joe, W7COM lives a long way and has become fully employed, George has become the likely successor to hold this post until new members become familiar with equipment and responsibilities. With those facts in hand the other four voting members voted George, N7GME as the new Chief Operator effective immediately.
