Event/Net SCHEDULING COORDINATION Form

(THIS FORM IS NECESSARY TO AVOID SCHEDULING CONFLICTS for WWRA MAINTENANCE and between WWRA USER GROUPS)

1. Requestor callsign & name
2. Type of event: parade, race, RACES, etc.
3. Dates and times-be specific - start to finish
 - a. If this event is long term such as a club net once a month, etc. then give details here
 - b. If it is a long term varying schedule then attach to this form
4. WWRA members sponsor (if any)
 - a. It is not a requirement for club or community use of repeater that there be a supporting WWRA member however a reliable point of contact, callsign, telephone number be available
5. Event sponsor, club, charity, community group, etc.

This form has become necessary to avoid scheduling issues between user groups and to keep shutting down of system while operations volunteers conduct maintenance on equipment.

Your cooperation is needed to keep this process a simple effort. We have kept this form simple as possible. No verbal, radio or telephone requests please.
